Zone 2:

Zone 3:

- All of **Santa Cruz County**
- Northern portion of **Pinal County** (excluding areas within Zone 1 and Zone 2 above)
- All of **Maricopa County** (except north of Interstate 10 [west of Phoenix] and west of Interstate 17 [north of Phoenix])
- Extreme southern **Gila County**, consisting of five mile buffer of the Gila River.
- Extreme SW corner of **Graham County**, encompassing a 5 mile buffer of the San Pedro River
- Extreme NW corner of **Cochise County**, encompassing a 5 mile buffer of the San Pedro River from county line south to Cascabel, AZ
